- REGULATION (EC) No 45/2001 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND COUNCIL of December 18, 2000;

3. WHAT DATA DO WE COLLECT AND WHY DO WE DO IT?

The data collected will be those necessary to carry out the services provided.

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

- The communication and marketing actions of services rendered;
- Management and provision of Services provided;
- Data anonymization for the purpose of carrying out market studies and the preparation of reports and studies.


OnRope may communicate data to legally competent entities in the scope of compliance with a legal obligation, a decision by the National Data Protection Authority, or a court order.

OnRope presumes that the data collected was inserted by the respective owner and that its insertion was authorized by the same, and that the data is true and accurate.

4. HOW IS THE DATA STORED?

The data collected will be processed and stored by OnRope and, when applicable, by entities contracted by the latter, and will only be used for the services provided.

The data collected shall be stored for a maximum period of 5 years after the end of its use.

5. SECURITY MEASURES

OnRope does its best to protect the personal data of users against unauthorized access on the Internet. Consequently, it uses security systems, rules, and other procedures so as to ensure the protection of users' personal data, as well as to prevent unauthorized access, improper use, disclosure, loss, or destruction of data.

It is, however, the user's responsibility to guarantee and ensure that the computer or device (smartphone, tablet, etc.) being used is properly protected from malicious software, computer viruses, and worms. - The right to be informed in the event of automated decision-making, the rationale underlying that system, and the importance and consequences of its treatment for the person in question.
